

NORVA Business Meeting Minutes

March 25, 2009

1. Treasurer's Report:
 - a. Current balance as of 2/28/09 is \$24,182
 - b. The board decided to set up a debit account for regular expenditures to avoid fees associated with writing checks.
2. 2nd Sunday meal at Lakewood Trinity Lutheran Church.
 - a. NORVA supports a community meal at the church. Our commitment includes:
 - i. \$150/month
 - ii. Volunteer labor
 - b. Average attendance at the meal is 40 people
 - c. There are 3 meals at Trinity: 1st Monday, 2nd Sunday (NORVA sponsored meal), 3rd Saturday– in Lakewood alone there are 18-20 meals provided by various churches
 - d. Monthly fee goes towards utilities during the meal and food. Food from the Cleveland Food Bank is .14 cents/lb. Paula orders meal and picks up the food from the Food Bank as volunteer for NORVA. Cleveland Community Kitchen (E. 152 and Shoreway) is another source for prepared foods.
 - e. Need more volunteers to help out with the setup, cooking, service and cleanup between 2 and 5 pm. Volunteers can come for all or part of the meal. Need about 9 volunteers to make it really work.
 - f. Volunteers from the church are planning to build a community garden at the church and help supply fresh food to the meals.
 - g. Produce giveaway at the church 3 times in the summer – free to those in need.
